Habitat for Humanity

- Habitat for Humanity of the Greater Teton Area was formed in 1995 under the umbrella of Habitat for Humanity International, which has been operating since 1976. Since then, we have built 18 homes in Teton County, WY. The homes are sold to partner families at no profit with an interest-free mortgage issued by Habitat. In 2010 Habitat launched a new program called *A Brush with Kindness* to provide exterior home repairs to qualifying low-income homeowners. In its first year *A Brush with Kindness* served 12 local families and 3 local organizations.
